Our courses are aimed at job seekers, employees or individuals who wish to improve their French language skills (A2, B1, B2 and C1 levels). They aim to improve the following language skills : writing, reading, listening and speaking. Our courses are structured around the recommendations of the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), a global standard used for describing language ability.

Requirements registration

Mastery of the Latin alphabet. A high school diploma is recommended.

Minimum A1 level, with DELF or TCF CERTIFICATE. **Beginner not accepted.**

In the case of exceptional online courses, you must have a computer or tablet and an internet

Administrative status

Your registration allows you to have the status of «stagiaire de la formation professionnelle continue» and to have a training certificate.

In addition, you can register for the DELF-DALF French language exam, which is recognised throughout the world.

Registration modalities - Two situations

1.You are paying for your training yourself

Fill out the online form before:

June 1, 2025, for the fall semester,
December 1, 2025, for the spring semester.

A level test will be carried on the dates shown in the table above.

2.You are requesting your employer or France Travail to finance your training

Fill out the online form before:

May 4, 2025, for the fall semester,
November 9, 2025, for the spring semester.

An online test will be sent and a date for an oral interview will be proposed to you.

Then, a quote or an agreement will be sent to your employer or France Travail.

The CILEC keeps the possibility to close a level group if there are not enough participants.

The cancellation conditions are available on the CILEC website and in your training agreement. The centre offers different payment modalities. For people living abroad, payment will be made by credit card online or bank transfer. For people living in France, payment can be made by bank transfer or directly in our offices by credit card (preferred).
